State Championship Team to USAD National Competition

DIVISION GROUPING

Beginning with the 2001 state competition, PAGE Georgia Academic Decathlon divided all participating schools into two divisions based on school enrollment. These two groups are known as **Division I (large schools)** and **Division II (small schools)**.

SELECTION of LARGE SCHOOL AND SMALL SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS

Following the completion of all competitive events at state competition, a championship team in each division (Division I and Division II) will be identified. The championship team in each division will be determined as the one with the highest Overall score for all ten events. There is also a first runner-up and second runner-up in each Division. The two team members having the highest score in each student category (top two Honors, top two Scholastic, and top two Varsity) will be counted as the team's Overall score for all ten events. The team member having the lowest score in each category will not be counted in the team's Overall score.

ADVANCING TO NATIONAL COMPETITION The Division I **OR** Division II championship team with the highest Overall score will earn the right to represent Georgia at the USAD national competition.

All schools advancing to national competition are divided into three divisions known as: **Division I (large)**, **Division II (medium)**, and **Division III (small)**. The Division I or Division II championship team from Georgia may, or may not, be in the same division at nationals. Schools are divided into three groups based on school enrollment.

In addition, the highest scoring medium sized school and the highest scoring small sized school based on USAD school size regulations, will represent Georgia in the USAD online national competition which is held concurrently with the traditional USAD national competition.
